5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Councilmember Brendan Jensen, concerning
6 miniature pigs amending City of Topeka Code § 6.35.030 and
7 repealing original section.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

10 Section 1. That section 6.35.030, Swine prohibited, of The Code of the City of
11 Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 **Swine prohibited.**

13 (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to rear or keep any swine in the city.

14 (b) This prohibition shall not apply to a person (i) who keeps no more than
15 three miniature pigs as pets; and (ii) each pig meets all of the following requirements:

16 (1) weighs less than 150 pounds;

17 (2) height less than 24 inches measured at the shoulder;

18 (3) vaccinated against pseudo rabies; and

19 (4) neutered or spayed upon reaching maturity.

20 Section 2. That original § 6.35.030 of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas,
21 is hereby specifically repealed.

22 Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
23 passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.

24 Section 4. This ordinance shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules,
25 or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.

26 Section 5. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared
27 invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this
28 ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
