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5 A RESOLUTION introduced by Interim City Manager Doug Gerber authorizing the City  
6 Engineer to conduct a survey prior to initiating condemnation proceedings to  
7 acquire a temporary easement and permanent easements for a sanitary sewer  
8 pump station (Improvement Project No. T-291011.00).

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10 BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Topeka, Kansas, pursuant to  
11 K.S.A. 26-201 that it is necessary and advisable in the public interest to condemn within the  
12 corporate limits of the City of Topeka certain private property interests, including a temporary  
13 easement and permanent easements, for the following public purpose: construction of a pump  
14 station and such other public purposes as are authorized by law.

15 Pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 26-201, the Engineering Division is hereby authorized  
16 and directed to cause a survey to be made by some competent engineer of the private property which  
17 is necessary to be appropriated for the improvements, and such other public purposes as are  
18 authorized by law, and the City Engineer, or designee, is authorized and directed to file the report of  
19 the survey, including a description of the private property and the interests to be acquired by  
20 condemnation, in the office of the City Clerk.

21 THIS RESOLUTION shall become effective upon one publication in the official city  
22 newspaper.
