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3 A RESOLUTION introduced by Doug Gerber Interim City Manager regarding the use of  
4 excess countywide retailers' sales tax that was in effect from January 1,  
5 2005 to December 31, 2016.  
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7 WHEREAS, the 2004 Interlocal Agreement ("Agreement") provides that excess  
8 countywide retailers' sales tax funds remaining after all infrastructure projects and other  
9 commitments specified in the Agreement are complete shall be distributed proportionally  
10 pursuant to the statutory formula in K.S.A. 12-192 unless the City and County agree  
11 otherwise; and

12 WHEREAS, the Shawnee County Commissioners have decided to use the County's  
13 share of the excess funds for replacement of the NW Carlson Road Bridge; and

14 WHEREAS, the City's share of the excess funds is approximately Ten Million  
15 Seventy-Two Thousand Eight-Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars (\$10,072,888.00).

16 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY THAT the excess  
17 funds remaining from the countywide retailers' sales tax levy will be used as follows:

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19 1. Upon approval by the governing body of a plan, five hundred thousand dollars  
20 (\$500,000.00) for the development of affordable housing and the redevelopment and  
21 revitalization of Topeka's neighborhoods.  
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23 2. The remainder of the funds will be used to support the Pavement Management Project  
24 (project # T-601071) as presented in the proposed 2018-2027 Capital Improvement Plan  
25 for projects that support pavement management program activities.
