

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION introduced by Doug Gerber Interim City Manager regarding the use of excess countywide retailers' sales tax that was in effect from January 1, 2005 to December 31, 2016.

WHEREAS, the 2004 Interlocal Agreement ("Agreement") provides that excess countywide retailers' sales tax funds remaining after all infrastructure projects and other commitments specified in the Agreement are complete shall be distributed proportionally pursuant to the statutory formula in K.S.A. 12-192 unless the City and County agree otherwise; and

WHEREAS, the Shawnee County Commissioners have decided to use the County's share of the excess funds for replacement of the NW Carlson Road Bridge; and

WHEREAS, the City's share of the excess funds is approximately ~~Ten Million Seventy-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Eight~~Nine Million Eight Hundred Thirty Six One Hundred Eighty Eight Dollars (~~\$10,072,888.00~~\$9,836,188.00).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY THAT the excess funds remaining from the countywide retailers' sales tax levy will be used as follows:

~~1. Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) will be designated to provide seed money to a non-profit community corporation and/or redevelopment authority dedicated to the development of affordable housing and the redevelopment and revitalization of Topeka's neighborhoods.~~

~~2.~~ The ~~remainder~~full balance of the funds will be used to support the Pavement Management Project (project # T-601071) as presented in the ~~proposed~~adopted 2018-

27 2027 Capital Improvement Plan for projects that support pavement management program
