	WHEREAS, K.S.A. 12-187 et seq., as amended, authorizes the Governing Body to	
12	submit to the qualified electors of the City the question of levying a special purpose	
13	retailers' sales tax to be collected by the Kansas Department of Revenue with revenue	
14	therefrom returned to this City; and	
15	WHEREAS, the Governing Body has determined that additional revenue is needed	
16	for the special purpose of certain improvements within the City.	
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE	
18	CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:	
19	Section 1.	A special question election shall be held in the manner prescribed by
20	law at the general election on November 6, 2018, for the purpose of submitting to the	
21	qualified electors of the City of Topeka, Kansas, the question of levying an additional	
22	special purpose retailers' sales tax in the City for the purpose of paying the costs of certain	
23	improvements within the City. The amount of the additional special purpose retailers' sales	
24	tax shall be five-tenths of one percent (0.5%), with the tax taking effect on October 1, 2019	
25	and expiring on October 1, 2029, if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.	
26	Section 2.	The proposition to be voted on shall appear on the ballot as follows:
27	"Shall the City of Topeka levy an additional retailers' sales tax in the amount of	
28	five-tenths of one percent (0.5%) to be used exclusively for costs of	
29	maintenance	e and improvements of existing City streets, gutters, curbs,

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30 sidewalks, alleys and street lighting, provided such tax shall take effect on
31 October 1, 2019 and expire on October 1, 2029?"

33 <u>Section 3</u>. If approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon, such tax shall 34 be subject to all applicable state laws and administrative rules and regulations of the 35 Kansas Department of Revenue. The services of the Kansas Department of Revenue 36 shall be utilized to administer, enforce and collect such tax.

37 <u>Section 4</u>. The City Clerk is authorized and directed to deliver this Resolution to 38 the Election Commissioner of Shawnee County, Kansas, who is authorized to and shall 39 give notice of the election, as provided by law, by newspaper of general circulation in the 40 City, as provided by K.S.A. 10-120, with the first publication to be not less than twenty-one 41 days prior to the date of the election. The vote at the election shall be by ballot, and the 42 proposition stated above shall be printed on the ballot, together with voting instructions as 43 provided by law.
