14	Committee and staff, the Governing Body supports submission of an application for
15	funding the following projects of the Bikeways Phase IV implementation:
16	• Downtown Connections – separated bike facilities connecting neighborhoods to
17	Downtown from SE 6th Avenue, Kansas Avenue Bridge, SW 8th Street, and the Landon
18	Trail
19	• Trail Connections – various neighborhoods connecting to the Shunga, Landon,
20	and Soldier Creek Trails
21	NW Tyler Street - a multi-use path on NW Tyler Street between Waddell Street
22	and Lyman Road
23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
24	CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS, that:
25	Section 1. The Governing Body authorizes the City Manager to submit an
26	application to the Kansas Department of Transportation for transportation alternatives

0	sufficient City match requirements needed for the construction, operation, and
1	maintenance of these three projects.

6	City is willing and able to administer the designing, letting and construction of these
7	projects, if any or all of these projects are selected for funding.
