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3 A RESOLUTION introduced by the members of the Public Infrastructure Committee
4 comprised of Council Members Neil Dobler, Tony Emerson, and Mike
5 Lesser recommending resumption of metered parking on certain
6 downtown streets.
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8 WHEREAS, since 2017, free parking has been allowed downtown on the 100 blocks
9 off of Kansas Avenue (east and west) between 6th and 10th streets; and

10 WHEREAS, there has been a significant decline in parking revenue since March,
11 2020, and a 2022 budget forecasting a deficit of \$1.3 million; and

12 WHEREAS, the members of the Public Infrastructure Committee, after considering
13 the matter on September 14, 2021, voted to recommend to the Governing Body: (1)
14 removal of the parking hoods on meters located on the 100 blocks off of Kansas Avenue
15 (east and west) between 6th and 10th streets; and (2) the imposition of two-hour metered
16 parking.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
18 CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS, that the City Manager is directed to facilitate the removal of
19 the parking hoods on meters located on the 100 blocks off of Kansas Avenue (east and
20 west) between 6th and 10th streets; and impose two-hour metered parking.
