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Is there a specific project that outlines the components of the HVAC project for a set amount of money? What details are available about the plan, costs, and priorities in order to understand components of the plan in order to make decisions?

Hannah Uhlrig stated she cannot recall the original plan, but knows there was an extended request related to the CIP amount for unanticipated expenses for the MEP and HVAC. She stated she can gather the historical information from the original plan to present to the GB.

#### What new radios were just purchased?

We recently purchased AED units for the fire department which is likely what the Councilmember was referencing.

Fire Department Fleet Disposal Process:

- Fire and Fleet Services determine what vehicle(s) need to be surplussed. There are several variables that determine which vehicles should be surplussed, and FASTER actually has a report that can help identify those vehicles through a 15-point system.
- Fire or Fleet starts the surplus process through CityWorks.
- The process flow goes through Division/Department/Contract & Procurement and then back to the Fire Chief
- Typically most assets are sold through GovDeals, so after Fleet Services has made the vehicle ready for auction, the vehicle is listed on GovDeals.
- Once the vehicle is sold, the buyer pays for the vehicle through GovDeals.
- After the vehicle is picked up, GovDeals releases the payment to the City.
