There has not been a complete assessment of the TPAC system. Given the system's age and condition, the assumption was made that the system would share many of the same deficits as the City Hall system.

The project proposal leverages approximately \$1.0m from the remaining City Hall Renovation budget to design the HVAC upgrades across City Hall and TPAC.

The current request is for additional spending authority of \$10.2m with a net project expense of \$6.5m.
