3 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Stephen Wade authorizing execution of a
4 loan agreement with Kansas Department of Health and Environment
5 ("KDHE") from the Kansas Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund
6 Act.

8 WHEREAS, under the terms of the Kansas Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund
9 Act, K.S.A. 65-3321 *et seq.*, the State of Kansas has authorized the making of the loans to
10 authorize applicants to aid in the construction of specific public project; and

11 WHEREAS, on September 6, 2022, the Governing Body authorized execution of a
12 loan application to KDHE and now desires to authorize the City Manager or designee to
13 complete the process by executing the loan agreement and any other documents
14 necessary to secure the loan.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
16 CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS, that:

17 Section 1. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to execute a loan
18 agreement and any other documents necessary to secure the loan from the Kansas Water
19 Pollution Control Revolving Fund.

20 Section 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its
21 adoption.
