3 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Stephen Wade authorizing execution of a
4 loan agreement with Kansas Department of Health and Environment
5 ("KDHE") from the Kansas Public Water Supply Loan Fund.

7 WHEREAS, the Topeka, Kansas (the "City") is a duly incorporated City of the First
8 Class, organized under the laws of the state of Kansas (the "State") which operates a
9 public water supply and distribution system (the "System"); and
10

11 WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City has heretofore determined that it is in
12 the best needs of the customers of the System to undertake certain modifications and
13 improvements (the "Project") to the System; and
14

15 WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 65-163c et seq. (the "Act"), the Kansas Department
16 of Health and Environment ("KDHE") administers the Kansas Public Water Supply Loan
17 Fund (the "Fund") from which loans are made to certain qualified Municipalities (as said
18 term is defined in the Act) to finance modification and improvements to public water supply
19 systems; and

21 WHEREAS, on September 6, 2022, the Governing Body authorized execution of a
22 loan application to KDHE and now desires to authorize the City Manager or designee to
23 complete the process by executing the loan agreement and any other documents
24 necessary to secure the loan.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
27 CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS, that:

28 Section 1. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to execute a loan
29 agreement and any other documents necessary to secure the loan to finance the Project.

30 Section 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its
31 adoption.
