9 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Deputy Mayor Neil Dobler, concerning unlawful
10 camping, amending § 9.45.360 of the Topeka Municipal Code.

13 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

15 Section 1. That section 9.45.360, Unlawful camping, of The Code of the City
16 of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

18 **Unlawful camping.**

19 It is unlawful and a public nuisance for any person to camp in the following areas:
20
21 (a) Public infrastructure;
22
23 (b) Within 10 feet of any doorway, loading dock, stairway or fire escape;

25 (c) Within an area bounded by Topeka Boulevard from SW 10th Avenue to
26 NW Crane Street; Madison Street from SE 10th Avenue to NE Crane Street; Crane
27 Street from Topeka Boulevard to NE Madison Street; and 10th Avenue from Topeka
Boulevard to SE Madison Street; and

28 (d) Within an area bounded by Topeka Boulevard from NW Curtis Street to
29 ~~NE Quincy~~NW Morse Street; NE Quincy Street from NE Curtis Street to NE Morse
30 Street; ~~NE~~ Morse Street from NE Quincy Street to NW Topeka Boulevard; and Curtis
31 Street from NE Quincy Street to NW Topeka Boulevard; and

32 (e) Within 500 feet of the center line of any trail or sidewalk inside city limits to
33 protect the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City.

34 Section 2. That original § 9.45.360 of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas,
35 is hereby specifically repealed.

38 Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its


passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.

Section 4. This ordinance shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules, or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 5. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
